



## Setting up a Dial up account on Window XP

1. If you are using the **Classic display mode** select **Start > Settings > Control Panel > Network Connections**.

Under **Network Tasks** select "Create a new connection".

Note: if you are prompted for location information and name, please enter your area code and "home" and select **OK**.

On the **New Connection Wizard** screen, select **NEXT**.

2. On the **Network Connection Type** screen, select **Connect to the Internet** and select **NEXT**.

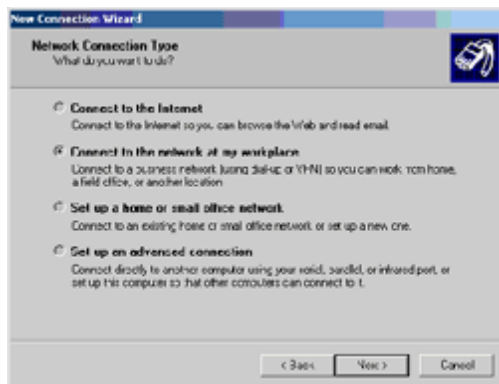


Figure 1: Network Connection Type

3. On the **Network Connection** screen, select **Dial-up-connection** and select **NEXT**.

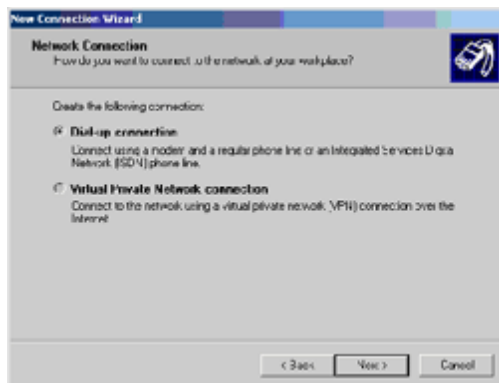


Figure 2: Network Connection

4. On the **Connection Name** prompt screen, type in "Dakota 2000" without the quotes, and select **NEXT**.

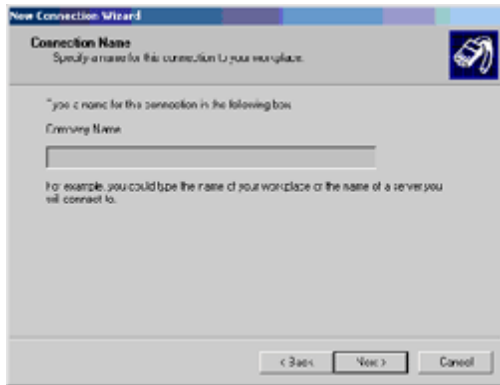


Figure 3: Connection Name

5. On the **Phone Number to Dial** prompt screen, enter 224-2712 and select **NEXT**.

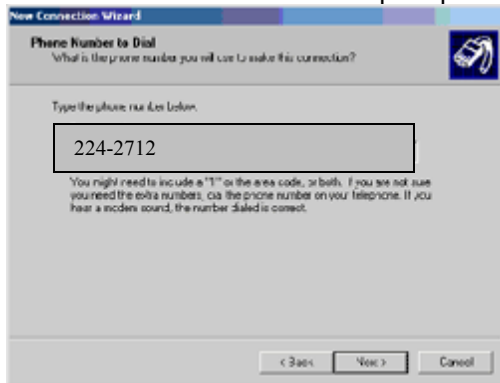


Figure 4: Phone Number to Dial

6. On the **Completing the New Connection Wizard** screen, select **Add a shortcut to this connection to my desktop** and select **FINISH**.
